### WOMENS ROWING

The Buckingham Ladies Rowing Club was founded in 1930 and one of its most outstanding performances came just two years later when a crew comprising Misses A Stewart (bow), M Johnson (2), C Sturgess (3), and L Patterson (stroke), defeated a visiting four from N.S.W.

Women's rowing went into recess at the outbreak of World War II and did not recommence in Tasmania until the late 1970's.

### 1990 – 2010 Adoption of FISA Age Divisions

Coinciding with the 1990 FISA World Championships at Lake Barrington the TRC adopted FISA internationally recognised age groups for its regatta and State Title programs. 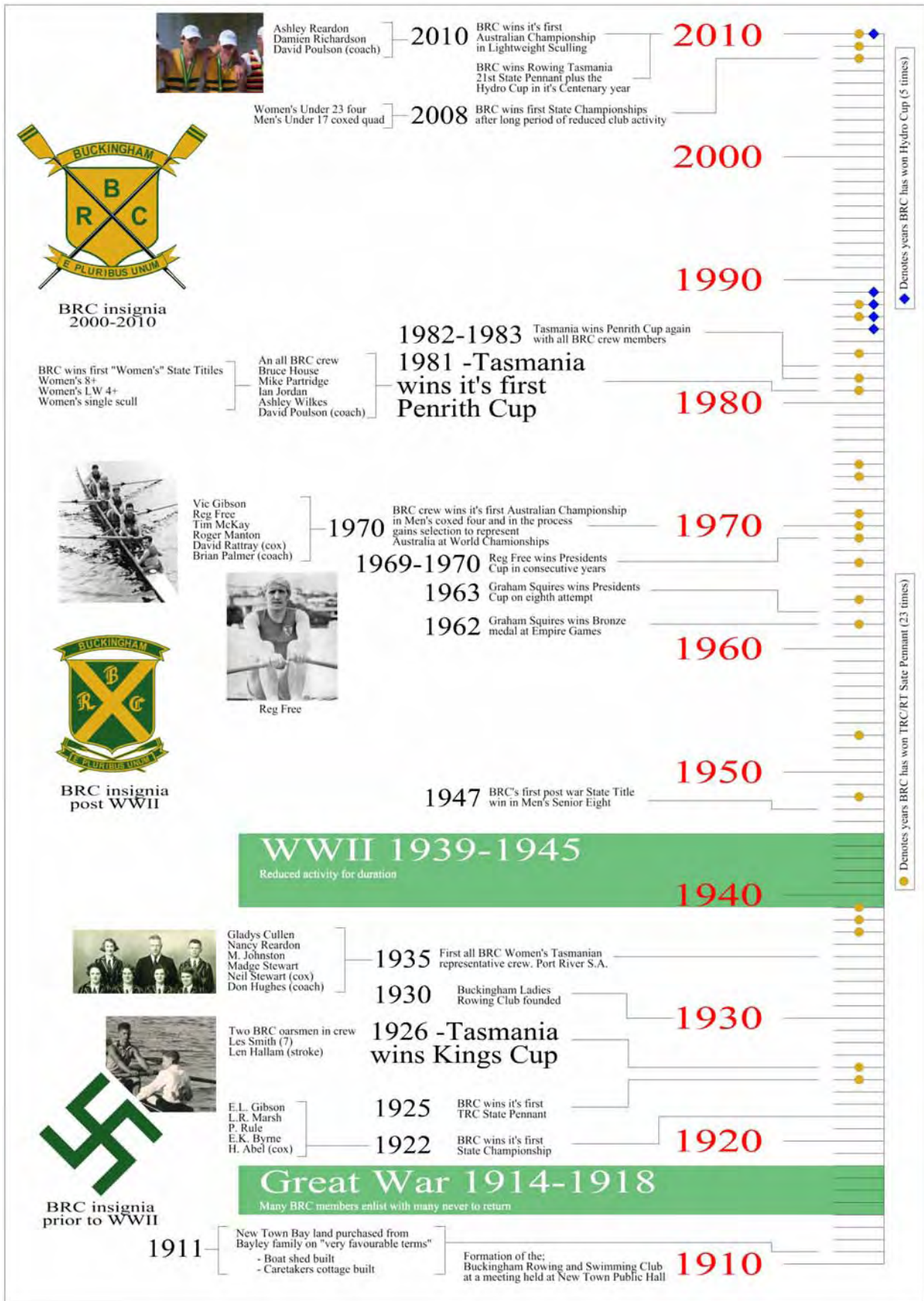
